Whereas, the President of the United States in his recent historic address to the 76th Congress on the State of the Nation made courageous utterance against all the forces of aggression and hate prevailing in the world, and whereas, he eloquently espoused the Cause of Religion as the basis of true Democracy and of international peace and good will, therefore, be it resolved, that the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, in Biennial Convention assembled, express to President Roosevelt its high admiration and deepest gratitude that in him America's finest traditional spirit of that "righteousness which exalteth a Nation" has found expression at a time when the world is in greatest need of it.
