United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation - 1945

Whereas, it has been reported that more human beings will die of starvation this winter than were killed by the atomic bomb, and

Whereas, the United States is the only major nation in default at this time of its pledged appropriations to the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration, and thereby will be held responsible by many people of the world for the death of millions unless action is taken at once,

Therefore, be it resolved, that the Executive Board of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, convened in executive session on December 10, 1945, in Cincinnati, urges the United States Congress to pass the UNRRA appropriation bill at once, before adjourning for the winter recess.
