ECONOMIC AID TO UNDERDEVELOPED AREAS - 1950

Whereas, hundreds of millions of people in Asia, Africa and elsewhere are demanding "better standards of life in larger freedom," and

Whereas, unless the poverty, ignorance and misery of these millions is relieved, they may turn to Communism, as offering their only hope of change, and

Whereas, lasting peace cannot be built in a world where the unfortunate so greatly outnumber the fortunate,

Therefore, be it resolved, that the 18th Biennial Assembly of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, convened in Cleveland, Ohio, November 12-15, 1950, urge the United Nations to speed its expanded program for technical and other economic assistance to underdeveloped areas, and records its hope that every member state will participate in this program to the full extent of its ability.
