DISARMAMENT - 1957

We realize that in today's dangerous world the United States must maintain its armed strength at a level adequate to defend our own country and be ready to aid in the defense of our free world associates. Nevertheless, we recognize the dreadful danger of the current arms race, particularly the race in weapons of mass destruction.

Therefore, be it resolved, that the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods in XXth Convention assembled in Los Angeles, California, February 13-16, 1955, on behalf of its United States units, applauds the efforts of the United States government in continuing disarmament discussions in the United Nations. At the same time we urge that our government take the initiative in speeding establishment of the International Atomic Energy Agency, which will develop the "atoms for peace" plan.

Further, be it resolved, that the NFTS XXth Biennial on behalf of its United States units urges the United States Government to continue negotiation for a universal enforceable disarmament.
